Principal's Update– Todd Corsetti

- Pre-ACT scores will be distributed once MHS receives the results.
- IB Testing information will be in the October Mav Express which comes out 10/1.
- Todd reported that in past years, at SHS, classes were on a trimester format and the students seemed to retain information even after almost a year since being in that subject. Teachers do a good job reviewing previous concepts. This is especially true in foreign language classes.

- Erik Reinholt introduced Rylee Poindexter, ASB President and Jordan Bayon, ASB Secretary so that thoughts and suggestions could be shared with the Student Council. 84 students are enrolled in Leadership 2. They do most of the events, drives and service projects. From MPACT money, Freshman and Seniors were provided free t-shirts.
