Guest - Daniel Hadi (student) Club Hope

- Club Hope supports students experiencing homelessness.
- There were about 47 homeless students in 20 at MHS experiencing, about 2500 in the district.
- Club hope services: Hope baskets (toiletries, food, school supplies and gears), Monte's closet , advocacy and awareness
- Club Hope is looking to start an adult advisory board for the 4 chapters (Southridge, Sunset and Beaverton Highschools). They are looking for 2 adults from each school. There will also be someone from the district and from the city council of Beaverton.

Principal report - Todd Corsetti

- Please consider volunteering
- Met with student council, good start of the year but the kids are tired. It's a lot to start back
- There are 3 confirmed COVID cases, which led to 60 students quarantined. They will be returning Thursday and Monday.
- BSD will release a dashboard that will show # of cases and quarantines throughout the districts.

- 55% of the MHS students are vaccinated. Only unvaccinated students need to quarantine. Students that are quarantined will have access to the materials for their classes on Canvas. No zoom classes.
- Drop off/pick-up has been a challenge. Remember lots of new student drivers and more parents are driving their children rather than sending them on the bus. It usually gets better a few weeks in. Washington county is looking into the timing of the lights
- Tik Tok trend of stealing from school has affected MHS. Reminder the school has a lot of cameras.
- Principal coffee, every 3rd friday of the month over zoom.
- Oct 6th virtual back to school
- Question about the tent on the patio: installed by the district, may request another one. Added table to hallway too to keep social distancing. Not possible to open more classes as there is no extra staff for supervision.
- Will parents be able to chaperone for homecoming? Most likely if vaccinated
